FORM ORDER FOR MEDIATION

The attached order, when filled out and signed by the parties' counsel of record, may be submitted as a proposed order to obtain entry of an order sending a proceeding to mediation.

No motion is required to be filed to request entry of the order.

If the matter is a contested matter, and not an adversary proceeding, the form should be modified (1) to alter the caption to refer only to the bankruptcy case, (2) to change references to the "adversary proceeding" to a specified contested matter (like an objection to claim) within the bankruptcy case, and (3) to change references to "Attorney for Plaintiff" and "Attorney for Defendant" as appropriate.
